Director's Note

In a hole in the ground there lived a hobbit.

Ten words that changed literature forever. Ten words that lead to the production of six of the greatest films ever made. Ten words that began my own journey into Middle Earth. Ten words that hold a special place in my heart and always will. Now these same ten words have lead to one of the greatest experiences of my life.

The Alban Arts Center is bringing Middle Earth to Saint Albans. As we follow the Hobbit Bilbo Baggins on his journey to help Gandalf and Thorin with his company of dwarves to reclaim their rightful home under the mountain from the villainous dragon Smaug. Bilbo quite reluctantly agrees to join them on their adventure. As we follow Bilbo, we see him not only experience the wonders and terrors of Middle Earth, but we see him become the unexpected hero.


