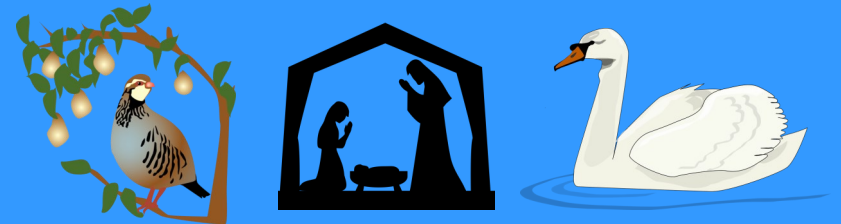

More than 30 years ago, I played an angel in my church's Nativity pageant, and faith and happiness were as simple as a tinsel halo.
